

Paik's After-School Martial Arts Academy

Interested in QUALITY After-School programming for your child that includes comprehensive martial arts training, homework time, and active and creative play that stimulates both the body and mind? If so, then we are the program for you.

We offer after-school pick-up from several west-side Madison and Middleton schools every day of the week. Once all of the children have arrived and had a healthy snack, we start our program with a 45 minute Taekwondo class taught by a black belt instructor trained to work with children and teach them the art, science, and history of the martial arts. The classes are energetic, fun, informative, and meet the standards necessary for your child to move through the belt levels necessary to progress toward higher ranks, and eventually toward black belt, if that is the path you should choose. We make a 100% guarantee that your child WILL NOT BE BORED.

After class, each child will be provided opportunities to work on homework (with a trained tutor on-site to assist if needed), engage in active games, do crafts, or continue to practice taekwondo if he/she so chooses. There will be PLENTY OF FUN activities and occasional field trips worked in with the taekwondo activities.

OUR PROGRAM IS ALREADY BEGINNING TO FILL UP QUICKLY. If you are interested, please fill out the attached form with basic information and your intention to participate and we will get back to you with all of the details.

We offer any number of days a week, your choice of days so long as we are given notice. Priority is given to families needing full week care.

The cost will be \$85.00 for 4 or 5 days, \$72.00 for 3 days, and \$59.00 for 2 days or less. Payment options are monthly or by semester.

Paik's Traditional Martial Arts After School Service Waiver and Release of Liability

General Activities:

I expressly warrant and represent that I am the parent or legal guardian of the Participant on whose behalf I am completing this registration, and have full legal authority to agree to the terms contained in the Waiver and Release of Liability. In this document, the Participant on whose behalf I am completing this registration is referred to as "my child." In sending my child to Paik's After School Service, I understand that I am giving my child permission to participate in all activities, including going on field trips.

Personal Property:

I understand that any items my child brings to PASS (cameras, personal electronics, and the like), while highly discouraged, are the sole responsibility of my child, and the camp is in no way responsible for lost items. Paik's may use any photos or video taken of my child this summer for promotion of the PASS program and recruitment purposes.

Assumption of Risk and Indemnity:

I acknowledge and fully understand that my child will be engaging in activities at Paik's that involve risk of injury. These activities include (a) controlled martial arts taught by trained black belt instructors, (b) swimming and other in-pool or lake activities that involve the risk of tripping, falling, slipping, drowning, and similar risks that could result in serious injury and/or death; and (c) field trips and other activities that involve the risk of tripping, falling, slipping, drowning, and similar risks that could result in serious injury and/or death. There may be other risks not known to us or not reasonably foreseeable at this time. I assume all the foregoing risks, accept personal responsibility for any damages incurred by my child following such injury, permanent disability, or death, and agree to indemnify and hold Paik's Traditional Martial Arts After School Service and its affiliates and partners in the operation of the school harmless from and against all claims, costs, expenses, and liabilities, including attorney fees, for injury to person or property arising in connection with my child's participation in school activities and use of facilities and equipment owned by Paik's and/or its affiliates or partners.

Waiver of Rights and Release of Liability:

I, on behalf of myself, my child, and my child's parents and/or legal guardians hereby release, waive, and discharge Paik's and their employees and agents from all losses, damages, claims, costs, expenses, and liabilities, including attorney fees, for injury to person or property arising in connection with my child's participation in school activities and use of the facilities and equipment owned by Paik's and/or their affiliates and partners, providing, however, that this waiver and release does not include injury, damage, or loss as a result of the intentional or reckless acts of Paik's.

Limitations of Damages:

I agree that my sole remedy, and the sole remedy of my child, his/her parents and legal guardians is a refund of the enrollment fee paid to Paik's for the session in which any injury, death, or property damage

occur. In no event shall the liability of Paik's, if any, to my child, the parent or legal guardian of my child, or any third party, whether in contract, tort (including negligence), or otherwise, exceed the enrollment fee (or portion thereof) actually paid to Paik's for the session during which such loss or damage occurs.

Waiver of Right to Bargain:

I have considered that if this Waiver and Release of Liability was not as broad as it is, the enrollment fee for the Paik's Traditional Martial Arts After School Service would be considerably higher. Since I do not wish to pay a significantly higher enrollment fee per session, I waive the right to bargain for different terms under this Agreement. I understand that I am waiving my right to bargain and accept the terms herein.

Severability:

If any portion of this Agreement is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall continue in full legal force and effect.

I acknowledge that I have carefully read the above Waiver and Release of Liability, understand its contents, and I recognize that by signing this legally binding Agreement on behalf of myself and my child and other parents or guardians of my child, we are freely giving up substantial rights and assuming all risk of injury, death, and property damage.

Paik's After School Services

Thank you for your enrollment in Paiks After School Services. We appreciate the opportunity to give your child the very best martial arts and after school experience possible, and look forward to continuing to work with you at improving your child's character and confidence.

Each day, a driver will pick up your child between 5 and 20 minutes after their school's dismissal at a point agreed upon by the child, parent, and Paiks.

After making all pickups on their route, the driver will drop the children off at Paiks where an experienced black belt instructor will supervise a snack and a 45 minute class. Some days, older or more advanced students will take a later class to facilitate a more individualized and accelerated curriculum.

PASS students may keep their uniforms and equipment at the dojang on specified storage racks located in the school.

Students will have access to the waiting room space in the dojang to work on homework, quietly socialize, or play with our toys, games, and crafts after their class is over.

If your child is unable to attend school, or must leave school early, please call us at your earliest convenience at **233-9999** so we can adjust accordingly.

When picking up your child, please locate our sign out sheet and fill out your initials and time, and check in with an instructor or assistant before departing.

Students enrolled in Black Belt Club or additional programs as weapons, team, and demonstration are invited to participate in these classes on the evenings they take place. Otherwise, expected pickup is by 5:30 p.m.. If you anticipate being late for the 5:30 pickup time, please give us a call at 233-9999. After 5:30, Paiks will add a \$5 charge per minute to your next payment unless we have been given notice.

If your child is to be picked up by someone not on their pickup list, we must have written consent given by someone on the pickup list no later than the day before pickup.

On days that schools have unusually early release, or service days, Paiks will offer day camps for a small additional fee. These camps will require a sack lunch and, on school service days, drop off in the morning between 7:30 and 8:30.

Students are expected to take their uniforms home and wash them every one or two weeks (5 – 8 classes). Sparring equipment should be taken home and cleaned with rubbing alcohol or sanitizer every two months.

Board Breaking classes require \$1 to cover costs for boards. You may either send your child with \$1 the day of, or pay a couple dollars extra on your monthly payment to cover the boards in advance. Students without their boards paid for may not be able to break.
